- * Choose *one* of the books that you read.
- * Choose *one* of the following options to present that book to the class in September.
 1. Create a puppet based on the main character in the story. Use the puppet to retell the story (beginning, middle, and end).

or
 2. Design a story bag where key items from the story are kept in the bag and shown as you retell the story (beginning, middle, and end).

or
 3. Make a vest out of a paper grocery bag. Draw or cut out pictures representing the beginning, middle, and end of the story. Wear the vest and use these pictures you drew or glued to the vest to help you retell the story.
